General Information**What To Bring:**

Bible, Pen, Notebook, Pillow, Sleeping Bag or Bed Sheets, Towels, Toiletry/Hygienic Items, and Money for snacks and other items.

Camp Rules:

- 1) Campers must be at least 13 years old or be accompanied by a parent or guardian.
- 2) All campers (whether leadership or student) are expected to remain on the campgrounds unless permission to leave has been secured from a camp director.
- 3) Use of tobacco in any form is strictly prohibited.
- 4) Modest clothing must be worn at all times.
- 5) It's impossible to ban all electronics but encourage them not to play games all the time – we want them interacting. No cell phones in worship services – bring a Bible or read the screen. 2-way walkie talkies are useful and acceptable, but must be used on channels other than 7 and 8.
- 6) Prank activities which deface the camp are forbidden.
- 7) All campers are exhorted to follow 1 Corinthians 10:31.
- 8) All vehicles are encouraged to rest from Monday afternoon until Friday morning. Please do not disturb them by using them as shuttles around the campground.

Clothing Guidelines:

Church sponsors are responsible for enforcing modesty standards for your own campers. Camp officers only step in if there's an ongoing problem. As such, these are recommendations rather than rules.

1) Hats, Caps, etc... are fine to wear any time except during worship services.

2) Campers are encouraged to wear shorts that are not too short or revealing. Many schools have a "while standing, past your fingertips" rule.

3) All shirts/tops should be long enough that they can cover the belt line. Be very conscientious on any shirt that can be considered "sleeveless" and tank tops aren't recommended for males or females. Also, please avoid see-through fabrics.

4) Any clothing bearing wording or illustrations should be acceptable for a Christian setting.

5) If you intend to swim, bring an item of clothing which was sold as a swimsuit. No one should see it unless they are in your cabin or at the pool with you if you are a girl. Campers must be fully covered going from their cabin to the pool.

6) Pants and shorts should fit your unique body style properly. Please avoid shorts and pants that are either too tight or too baggy as either can be revealing.

7) There is not specific dress code for Evening Worship but many campers dress up a little more for this service. Be picky in your presentation for Evening Worship and you will not be disappointed!
